Policy and Objectives

Wong Tai Sin District Healthy & Safe City (WTSDHSC) is committed to achieve a safe and healthy environment for all people in Wong Tai Sin District, by the implementation of Community Safety Programs (CSP) based on the health and safety needs of the District. Accordingly, we will maintain official policies and objectives to provide a high level of care for the community. WTSDHSC will review these policies and objectives annually to ensure the changes in Wong Tai Sin District are well reflected.

WTSDHSC's Policies are:

- *To promote community safety and health by establishing safe environments and healthy habits in daily living;*
- *To recognize major safety and health issues and for such purposes to make innovative changes by pooling community resources and concerted efforts;*
- *To create supportive environments for promoting and sustaining the safety and health of Wong Tai Sin citizens through inter-sectoral participation and community partnership;*
- *As a community platform, the WTSDHSC enables people of all races, religions, political beliefs, economic or social statuses to have equal access to health care; and*
- *To work closely with the Occupational Safety and Health Council (OSHC) and other relevant bodies for advancing the objects of the WTSDHSC.*

WTSDHSC's objectives are to increase the safety & health promotion awareness of residents Wong Tai Sin District and collaborate with other stakeholders in the WTSDC to promote injury prevention in a proactive manner. To achieve these objectives, the following target is established: To implement at least one community safety program for injury prevention annually.
